

EU Directive 2002/96/EC The WEEE Regulations

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE' Directive) has passed into UK legislation.

The regulations require that electrical and electronic equipment that does not have a fixed location and was placed on the market after 13th August 2005 must be clearly identified as such. Genlab Limited have marked those Genlab products to which the regulations apply with the 'Wheelie Bin' symbol in accordance with BS EN 50419:2006 - 'Marking of electrical and electronic equipment in accordance with Article 11 (2) of Directive 2002/96/EC (WEEE)'.

The regulations also require that Genlab Limited register as a producer of such items and make provisions for the collection and recycling of such equipment placed on the market after 13th August 2005 within the UK. Genlab have joined an industry compliance scheme managed by Valpak Ltd and have been allocated the Producer Registration Number: WEE/DA0044SY. Details of collection and recycling arrangements are available at the address above or via email to enquiries@genlab.co.uk. This only applies to equipment supplied within the UK.

Where Genlab equipment is supplied through a distributor or agent to other countries of the EU, it is understood that the 'producer responsibility' resides with that distributor or agent.
